The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of March 11, 2019 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Signed the proclamation for North Iowa Area Community College-NIACC Trojans Day for March 23, 2019. Signed Wellmark documents: Wellmark rate sheet and Medicare Secondary Payer (MSP) Addendum sheet. Approved increase in health insurance rates of 5.1 % for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Signed Self Insured Services Company (SISCO) Service Agreement Addendum A. Awarded the project for Drainage District no. 100 Main Tile Improvement to Rognes Brothers Excavating, Inc., Lake Mills, Iowa, in the amount of \$123,733.25 as the best and lowest of six bids.

On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Approved the dental rates for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 with no increase to the rates. No change, from Fiscal Year 2018-2019, to the calculation of the employee's contribution to health and dental for Fiscal Year 2019-2020. Approved the quote from Signs & Designs, Inc. for vinyl on the windows and door at the Public Health/Conservation/Sanitarian/Veterans Affairs building with the County paying up to \$375 of the cost of the vinyl. Approved the quote from Next Generation Technologies for three Surface Pro tablets for the Board of Supervisors for the amount of \$1,497.98 for each tablet.

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-012 ESTABLISHMENT OF 5 TON EMBARGO

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 321.471 and 321.472 of the Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors may establish a road embargo on the Secondary Road System, and

WHEREAS, inclement weather is producing a condition where heavy loading is extremely detrimental to the Secondary Road System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the County Engineer be authorized to order any of the Secondary Roads closed to vehicles in excess of five (5) tons per axle, wherever he deems it necessary and for the period of time deemed expedient (not to exceed 90 days), by erecting signs in accordance with Section 321.472.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer may grant permits of exemption upon a showing that there is a need to move to market farm produce of a type subject to rapid spoilage, or loss of value or to move any farm feeds or fuel for home heating purposes.
