The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of April 26, 2021 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Approved the best of two quotes received for a server for the camera system in the amount of \$7,489.99 from Next Generation Technologies. Hiring of summer help in the Secondary Road Department: Luke Hansen effective May 10, 2021 at \$12.00 per hour, Lucas Weiland effective May 17, 2021 at \$12.00 per hour, and Nick Davis effective June 3, 2021 at \$11.00 per hour. Approved the Revised Hancock County policy regarding compensation for damages for drainage district projects for 2021. Set June 14, 2021 at 11:00 a.m.in the Basement Meeting Room of the Law Enforcement Center as the date and time for a formal hearing with landowners of Drainage District no. 57.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Approved the construction permit application to modify the master matrix only at an existing swine confinement facility for Nutra Tech located in section 17, Erin Township. Certification of cost allocation plan as submitted by Cost Advisory Services and based on fiscal year ending June 30, 2020 and to establish cost allocation of billings for use in Fiscal Year 2022. Set June 7, 2021 at 11:00 a.m. in the Basement Meeting Room of the Law Enforcement Center as the date and time for an informal hearing for Drainage District no. 34.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Tlach and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following resolution:

RESOLUTION No. 2021-025 NOXIOUS WEED NOTICE

TO ALL LANDOWNERS, OCCUPANTS AND PERSONS IN POSSESSION OR CONTROL INCLUDING RAILROADS, LANDS, AND LOTS WITHIN HANCOCK COUNTY, IOWA:

The Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, Iowa, in a meeting held on May 3, 2021 passed the following Resolution, to wit:-

BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County, Iowa, that pursuant to the provision of Chapter 317, Code of Iowa, it is hereby ordered:-

1. That each owner and each person in possession or control of any land or lots in Hancock County, Iowa, shall cut, burn or otherwise destroy all noxious weeds thereon, as defined in this Chapter, at such times, in each year, in such manner as shall prevent said weeds from blooming or coming to maturity, and shall keep said lands free from such growth of any other weeds, as shall render the streets and highways adjoining said land unsafe for public travel. Noxious weeds shall be cut or otherwise destroyed on or before the following dates and as often thereafter as is necessary to prevent seed production.

GROUP 1: June 15, 2021 for leafy spurge, perennial peppergrass, sour dock, smooth dock, sheep sorrel, and common and glossy buckthorn.

GROUP 2: June 15, 2021 for Canadian thistle, bull thistle, other thistle belonging in genera or cirsium, Russian knapweed, quack grass, wild mustard, shatter cane, teasel and palmer amaranth. GROUP 3: July 15, 2021 for field bindweed and wild carrot.

GROUP 4: July 15, 2021 for sunflower, horse nettle, perennial sow thistle, cocklebur, butter print (velvet leaf), puncture vine, poison hemlock, multi-flora rose and marijuana.

- 2. That each person and owner in possession or control of any land in Hancock County, infested with any noxious weed, as listed above, shall adopt a program of weed destruction prescribed by the Weed Commission which in five years may be expected to destroy and will immediately keep under control such infestations of said noxious weeds.
- 3. That all weeds other than noxious weeds on all county truck primary and local county roads and between the fence lines thereof, shall be treated by the adjoining property owners to prevent seed production on or before JULY 15, 2021.
- 4. That if the owner or person in possession or control of any land in Hancock County, Iowa, fail to comply with the foregoing orders, the Weed Commission shall cause this to be done and the expense of said work including costs of serving notice and other costs, if any, to be assessed against the land and the owners thereof.
- 5. That the County Auditor be and she is hereby directed to cause notice of the making and entering of the foregoing order by publication in each of the official newspapers in Hancock County, Iowa.

On motion by Supervisor Tlach, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following resolution:

RESOLUTION NO. 2021-026

APPROVAL OF TRANSPORTATION SAFTEY IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM APPLICATION FOR TEMPORARY TRAFFIC SIGNALS

WHEREAS, the Iowa Department of Transportation has adopted Administrative Rule 761 - Chapter 164, which created the Traffic Safety Improvement Program (TSIP) to allow for funding to be provided to local jurisdictions for eligible traffic safety improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, Hancock County has determined that providing temporary traffic signals for use during maintenance activities will aid in improving safety for flaggers, maintenance workers, and the traveling public in road work zones; and

WHEREAS, portable temporary traffic signals are recognized temporary traffic control devices in the Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices, 2009 Edition; and

WHEREAS, the Hancock County Engineer recommends a TSIP application be submitted to the Iowa Department of Transportation for possible safety funding of the above-mentioned traffic control devices.

IT IS THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors to endorse the above-mentioned project and hereby commits to accepting and maintaining these temporary traffic signals;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairperson of the Hancock County Board of Supervisors authorize and direct the County Engineer to submit the said funding application to the Iowa Department of Transportation for possible Traffic Safety Improvement Funding.

RESOLUTION 2021-027 FARM TO MARKET REVIEW BOARD APPLICATION

WHEREAS, a county may apply for modifications to its farm to market system to add or subtract mileage from its system, to accept or delete highways gained or lost through jurisdictional transfers, or to change the classification of roads within its system, and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of HANCOCK County has consulted with its County Engineer and desires to modify its farm to market road system to provide continuity of intra-county and inter-county routes, to meet the needs of existing or potential traffic, to better meet land use needs, or to provide a more suitable location for a farm to market route, and

WHEREAS, application for modifications to any county's farm to market system must be made to the Farm to Market Review Board per the requirements of Code of Iowa Section 306.6,

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF HANCOCK COUNTY that this county is formally requesting that the Farm to Market Review Board approve the following modifications to its farm to market system:

Road segments proposed for addition to the farm to market system:

On R44, from B16 to B14.2.0 milesOn 130th Street, from R18 to Deer Avenue.2.0 milesOn Deer Avenue, from B63 to 130th Street.1.0 mile

Total Mileage added to the Farm to Market System: 5.0 miles

Resolution No. 2021-028 Bridge Weight Limit Posting

WHEREAS, in accordance with requirement of the Federal Government, certain bridges located on the Secondary Road System must be posted with load limit signs; and,

WHEREAS, A bridge inspection program covering all Secondary Highway bridges in Hancock County, is being completed biennial; and,

WHEREAS, Several such bridges have been found to require load limit posting as determined by criteria established by the Federal Government.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors on this 3rd day of May, 2021 as provided in Sections 321.471, 321.472, and 321.473, Code of Iowa, to erect and/or maintain weight limit signs in advance of the following bridges located on the Federal Aid, Farm to Market, and Local Secondary Road System. The Engineer is instructed to place or cause to be placed, all necessary signs to comply with this resolution. Only those bridges determined to have a weight restriction below LEGAL, in the listing included herein, will be required to have signs erected

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: Due to changes in the status of bridges on Secondary Roads in Hancock County brought about by repair, replacement, or re-inspection, all previous resolutions regarding the posting of these bridges in Hancock County is hereby superseded.
