NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Hancock County that the county budget amendment #1 for Fiscal Year 2025-2026, as set forth in the budget summary, is hereby adopted and the Hancock County Auditor is directed to file said budget and to establish accounting records in accordance with the below listed schedule.

Hiring of Issac Zebedee, Conservation Director, effective August 13, 2025 at \$65,000 per year.

On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Jermeland and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Invoice for tilework completed in four bathrooms in the Courthouse and Law Enforcement Center with Nuncio's Construction in the amount of \$16,830. Allowance and disallowance of various homestead, military and disabled veteran homestead tax credit applications.
