The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Osmund (Bud) Jermeland present. Absent: none.

On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board approved the tentative agenda. On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried, the Board approved the minutes of March 2, 2026.

On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Approved Iowa Department of Transportation agreement No: 2-26-HBP-S-005 for Project No.: BROS-C041(155)—8J-41 for county highway bridge program project. Signed Independent Contractor agreement with Stacie Hansen for cleaning at the 545 State Street Building (Hancock County Public Health) from March 9, 2026 to May 4, 2026.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Authorized use of credit card for Hancock County Treasurer, Linda Juhl. Payroll change for Issac Zebedee, Conservation Director, for completion of 6 months, effective February 22, 2026 in the amount of \$34.45 per hour. Class C retail alcohol license with outdoor service for Slippery Elm Inc. doing business as Slippery Elm Golf Course.

RESOLUTION NO. 2026-012

ESTABLISHMENT OF 5 TON EMBARGO

WHEREAS, under the provisions of Chapter 321.471 and 321.472 of the Code of Iowa, the Board of Supervisors may establish a road embargo on the Secondary Road System, and

WHEREAS, inclement weather is producing a condition where heavy loading is extremely detrimental to the Secondary Road System.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the County Engineer be authorized to order any of the Secondary Roads closed to vehicles in excess of five (5) tons per axle, wherever he deems it necessary and for the period of time deemed expedient (not to exceed 90 days), by erecting signs in accordance with Section 321.472.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the County Engineer may grant permits of exemption upon a showing that there is a need to move to market farm produce of a type

subject to rapid spoilage, or loss of value or to move any farm feeds or fuel for home heating purposes.

On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following Resolution:
