## CRITERIA FOR FIREWORKS DISPLAY APPLICATIONS

## ALL APPLICANTS MUST CAREFULLY READ THE FOLLOWING

The following entities are **permitted to apply** for a fireworks display permit under Iowa Law:

municipalities,

fair associations;

amusement parks; or

other organizations or groups of individuals.

A fireworks permit CANNOT, under Iowa Law, be issued to an individual.

A fireworks permit **will not be issued** unless the application:

is fully and truthfully completed;

is signed by the applicant AND property owner;

verification of **insurance** coverage **is attached** to the application;

all operators are over 18 years of age and competent to conduct such a display; and the location where the display will occur is **outside the city limits** of any town.

Under Iowa Law, a permit is NOT required for incorporated county fairs.
