The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

The minutes of May 30, 2019 meeting were read and approved.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Approved the quote from Bergo Environmental, Mason City, in the amount of \$950 for survey of asbestos in the Annex building. Accepted the completion of work report for Drainage District no. 1 and 2 West Main, Drainage District no. 1 and 2 West Main Lateral 24 and Drainage District no. 38 Main A and set June 24, 2019 at 10:00 a.m. as the date and time for completion of work hearing for Drainage District no. 1 and 2 West Main, Drainage District no. 1 and 2 West Main Lateral 24 and Drainage District no. 38 Main A.

A public hearing was held on the permit application for Nutra Tech for one new 2450 head deep pit swine finisher confinement building at an existing swine confinement facility in Section 17, Erin Township. Certification that publication as to the date and time of the hearing was on file in the Auditor's Office. Those present for the hearing were Supervisors Tlach, Greiman, and Rayhons, Auditor Michelle K. Eisenman, and Zoning Administrator Andy Buffington. Present from the public were Grace Zaplatynsky and Angela Nelson. Andy Buffington spoke about the application. There were no written or oral comments for or against the application. On motion by Supervisor Rayhons, seconded by Supervisor Greiman and carried, the Board voted to unanimously approve the application. This recommendation will be forwarded onto the Iowa Department of Natural Resources, as defined by law.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons, and carried, the Board authorized the County Auditor to issue checks for the claims on file this date, June 3, 2019. A full listing of all claims paid in June, 2019 will be published in June 17, 2019 minutes.
