The Hancock County, Iowa, Board of Supervisors met in adjourned session on the above captioned date pursuant to adjournment with Supervisors Florence (Sis) Greiman, Gary Rayhons, and Jerry J. Tlach present. Absent: none.

On motion by Supervisor Greiman, seconded by Supervisor Rayhons and carried unanimously, the Board gave approval to the following: Signed the proclamation for National 4-H Week for October 6-12, 2019. Signed Hancock County Foundation grant award in the amount of \$5,020 for the Hancock County Sheriff for a patrol video system.

**RESOLUTION No. 2019-036**

**ESTABLISHING SPEED LIMIT ON 285<sup>th</sup> STREET ON THE EAST SIDE OF THE TOWN OF HAYFIELD IN HANCOCK COUNTY, IOWA**

**WHEREAS**, The Board of Supervisors is empowered under authority of Sections 321.255 and 321.285(4), of the Code of Iowa, to determine upon the basis of an engineering and traffic investigation that the speed limit of any secondary road is greater than is reasonable and proper under the conditions existing, and may determine and declare a reasonable and proper speed limit, and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Hancock County Board of Supervisors that the speed limit be established and appropriate signs erected at the locations described as follows:

**On 285<sup>th</sup> Street located in Hancock County, Iowa;**

**West & East Bound Traffic**

1. 25 MPH commencing from a point approximately 75 feet East of the intersection of Oak Avenue and 285<sup>th</sup> Street (B20); thence running along Oak Avenue approximately 1,700 feet to the East.

**This Resolution shall be in effect when the signs have been erected**

No further business to come before the Board, motion made to adjourn at 11:28 a.m. by Supervisor Greiman and carried. All Supervisors present voting, "Aye," session to adjourn and will meet again on October 7, 2019.
