

Hancock County is offering for sale by sealed bid the following items:

Lot 1: Onan 75kW Emergency Standby Generator (Model 75.ODYC-15R/19610K), Allis Chalmers motor, 2 – 12 volt Deka 950 CCA batteries (Model 1131PMF) and Pryco Fuel Pump, installed in 1983.

Lot 2: 2 – 2,000 gallon diesel fuel tanks (rectangular), double-walled in cement, installed in 1992. Estimated weight without fuel is approximately 17,500 to 25,000 lbs.

Successful bidder is responsible for safe removal and transport off the property of the items at their expense. The successful bidder will be responsible for any damages caused during the removal. The successful bidder shall provide proof of bidder's general liability insurance with liability coverage exceeding \$1,000,000 dollars in personal and property coverage and/or obtain a surety bond in the amount of \$10,000 dollars payable to Hancock County. The generator will be disconnected from power and decommissioned prior to the end of the bidding period. Purchased lot(s) must be removed from the property by April 30, 2023.
